NMI's mission is to develop, manage and promote k-adult language, cross-cultural educational and leadership opportunities

NMI's scholarships to students of color entering or enrolled in college. The three Scholarships available one \$1,000.00 and two \$500.00 for one semester during the academic year.

The NEW EXDENDED deadline is Friday, May 12nd, 2017.

The Nuestro Mundo Inc. Scholarship recognizes outstanding high school students in their senior year who have shown commitment to the Dual Language Immersion (DLI) Program with previous involvement in volunteer/leadership or community activities.

REQUIREMENTS:

1. Applicants must have attended Nuestro Mundo Community School

2. Include a copy of your high school transcript.

3. Upon receiving the NMI scholarship, recipients must be enrolled for a minimum of 6 credits during the semester in which they receive the scholarship at an accredited Wisconsin College or University.

4. Demonstrate Financial Need

5. Include one letters of recommendation from a classroom teacher, employer, volunteer program coordinator or other community member who can speak about your motivation for higher education and address your academic, volunteer and community achievements. The letter can be in English or Spanish.

6. Must complete an interview with Scholarship Review Board

7. If awarded must partake in video marketing for NMI

*Preference will be given towards students whom remained within the DLI program through out their education career

<u>SELECTION</u>: Selection is based on DLI Program commitment, financial need, and responses to short essay questions, recommendation, and high school transcript. A FAFSA is not required to apply.
